

Car-Park Information

Sustaining and enhancing our environment is important to the University of Worcester, and we have worked both with the Carbon Trust and as a pilot on the EcoCampus programme to promote environmentally responsible practices in all aspects of University life.

If you do choose to bring your car to University, you will need to pay car park charges or buy a parking permit. Please note this does not guarantee you a parking space as we limit parking for all on campus and are continuously reviewing our green travel policies.

- Charges in the long stay car park will be £2 per day (£1 for evenings after 5pm and weekends)
- Charges in the short stay car parks will be 70p per hour (day rate), £1 for evenings after 5pm, and weekends
- Charges in car park A (the super short stay car park) will be 50p per 30 minutes parking (9am – 5pm). Weekends and evenings £1.
- Student car parking permits for those resident more than one mile from campus will be available at £95 per annum, valid from 1st August 2009 to 31st July 2010. Students requiring a permit for a set 6 month semester period (1st August – 31st January; or 1st February to 31st July inclusive) will be able to purchase a permit for these periods for £50. **A parking permit application form is on the second page of this leaflet.**
- Students living on campus and within one mile of the campus are strongly discouraged from bringing a car onto campus between the hours of 9am and 5pm. Car parking permits for those who are resident on campus or less than one mile from campus will be available at £200 per set semester period.

Parking permits are provided free of charge to holders of disabled parking badges. If you hold a disabled badge, you can bring a car onto campus and park in any of the designated disabled bays provided you display both your badge and permit.

Students and staff are strongly encouraged to find other ways of travelling to and from campus than by car and/or to car share.
