WHEREAS in accordance with section 124A(3) of the Education Reform Act 1988^(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), the Privy Council by Order dated 5th March 1993 made an instrument of government for the Worcester College of Higher Education being a higher education corporation with respect to which Schedule 7 to the Act has effect:

AND WHEREAS section 124A(3)(b) of the Act provides that the Privy Council may by Order modify an instrument of government of any such higher education corporation:

AND WHEREAS the Privy Council by Order dated 10th August 1999 modified the instrument of government to provide for a change of name to University College Worcester:

AND WHEREAS in accordance with the instrument of government, the Corporation have again changed their name with the consent of the Privy Council:

NOW, THEREFORE, Their Lordships, in exercise of the powers conferred on Them by section 124A(3)(b) of the Act, are pleased to modify the instrument of government in accordance with the provisions set out in the Schedule to this Order, with effect from 5th September 2005.

SCHEDULE

MODIFICATIONS TO THE INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT REFERRED TO IN THE FOREGOING ORDER

1. In paragraph 1(1) –
 - (a) for “University College Worcester” *substitute* “University of Worcester” (twice); and
 - (b) for “Secretary of State for Education and Employment” *substitute* “Secretary of State for Education and Skills”.
2. In paragraphs 1(1), 3(2)(b), 3(5)(a), 3(6), and 6(4), wherever it appears, for “College” *substitute* “University”.
3. In paragraphs 1(1) and 3(1), wherever it appears, for “Principal” *substitute* “Vice Chancellor and Chief Executive”.
