

ResNet Quick Start Guide

This guide will show you in as few steps as possible how to get connected to the ResNet service. Please refer to the “Resnet and Wireless Quickstart Checklist” for the items and information you will need during this procedure.

Getting On-Line

Step 1: Your computer's network card must be connected to the network wall socket in the UW halls of residence using the cable provided.



Network cables have end connectors like these



Network wall sockets look like this



The corresponding socket on your PC or Mac will look something like this

Step 2: Once you've connected the network cable to your network point and the computer itself, your computer should automatically connect to ResNet. We recommend Windows Vista and Windows 7 users select “Public” when prompted by the network wizard.

Step 3: Load up your web browser. Try visiting www.google.com or any other website and you should be redirected to our ResNet page. This is where you enter your University-provided user name and password. For students this is the same as your main network login. Enter your username and password, select “I agree to abide by the UW IT regulations”, and click on “Log In”
