

Worcester Research and Publications (WRaP) Deposit Policy

It is the policy of the University of Worcester that a copy of all research output since 2008 should be deposited in WRaP. Research from 2000 can also be deposited. Items may only be deposited by accredited members of the University of Worcester.

Subject to copyright permission, the types of material which can be deposited include:

Journal articles, books, chapters in books, book reviews, conference papers, conference posters, powerpoint presentations (where accompanied by conference papers), PhD theses, Masters theses, inaugural lectures, and abstracts (where there is a link to the full-text online).

Documents should be submitted as PDF files. Repository staff will change documents to the appropriate format if necessary.

All work must be original and must not infringe copyright (including Third Party copyright). The validity and authenticity of the work is the sole responsibility of the depositor.

In the case of work which has more than one author the depositing author must have the consent of each author for the work to be submitted to the WRaP.

Repository staff have the right to change any of the existing metadata if necessary.

Repository staff will add the university email address for the depositing author unless requested not to do so.

The University of Worcester retains the right to remove items for professional and administrative reasons, or if a work is found to violate the rights of any individual. (See University of Worcester Takedown Policy).

WRaP is compliant with Open Access standards. Research will appear in specialist services that harvest standards-compliant open access databases, and conventional Internet search engines.
