Fees and funding

In this section you will find information on fees, loans and financial support, so you can work out how much it will cost to come to university and what help is available.

While you are studying at Worcester, you will need to pay annual tuition fees to us. You will also need to consider other expenses such as living costs, accommodation fees and study materials.

A wide range of financial support is available to help you cover the cost of your studies, throughout the duration of your course.

Fees for 2012

The Government has recently introduced new funding arrangements for higher education. This means the withdrawal of the great majority of public funding for higher education. The University of Worcester is one of the very few universities, known for their high-quality qualifications, who are charging the actual cost (rather than the maximum amount established by the Government).

The fees at Worcester reflect the cost of efficiently providing an excellent education. We believe that once a student is selected to study here, they become a member of our community. This informs everything we do.

At Worcester, we are committed to providing our future students with the same worldclass education and state-of-the-art facilities available to our students today. We will be introducing a raft of measures to ensure that we continue to attract the most talented, ambitious students regardless of their financial circumstances.

An overview of tuition fees at the University of Worcester in 2012

- The standard annual fee for full-time undergraduate study for UK/EU students enrolling in 2012 is £8,100 per year. Full-time undergraduate courses normally take three years to complete.
- Varying fees apply for Foundation degrees and HNDs. For the majority of Foundation Degree courses, which are completed over two years, an annual tuition of £6,000 will apply. Most HNDs in 2012/13 will cost £7,000.
- The University proposes to charge on a pro rata basis for part-time study, subject to final approval.
