

Access to Nutritional Therapy

This module aims to develop the underpinning knowledge and skills to prepare students to study nutrition or nutritional therapy at Master's level. It is designed to enable students to develop their knowledge of nutrients and their effects on human physiology and cell biochemistry.

The module will also consider current dietary guidelines and will explore the implications of selected dietary changes on health outcomes.

This module is also a level 6 access module for the MSc Nutritional Therapy programme. Successful completion of this module at grade C or above may be an entry requirement for some applicants to the MSc programme.

To progress onto the Nutritional Therapy Masters the IELTS score required for international applicants is 7, with a minimum of 6.5 in each area. Other English Language qualifications will be considered.
