The current SEND and AP Improvement plan (HM government, 2023) aims to “fulfil children’s potential: children and young people with SEND (or attending alternative provision) enjoy their childhood, achieve good outcomes and are well prepared for adulthood and employment” (p.9). It recognises that improvements need to be made within the EHCP system to reduce bureaucracy and restore parent’s trust that their children will get prompt access to the support they need.

The aims of this session are:

- To highlight successes and barriers to the EHCP process.
- To support EHCP application writing.
