1.Teaching Practice - PebblePad

Lesson Observations

Trainees are expected to have 4-6 formal observation by the end of Term 2.

The role of informal feedback is highly valued and trainees are encouraged to capture this as notes their **PebblePad Professional Discussions** log. This includes, informal discussions on planning and teaching, mentor meetings and discussions with placement colleagues.

Professional Report 2 (PR2)

Trainees and mentors should complete PR2 in PebblePad by Friday 22nd March please.

2. Module PGFE4004: Curriculum, Research- informed teaching and professionalism - This module has 1 assignment submitted in 2 parts

Assignment B

Part 1 Literature Review

Trainees should choose a relevant topic linked to professional interest/dilemma. Trainees then research their topic and complete critical literature review. Submission Friday 3rd May 3:00 PM

Part 2 Presentation

Trainees present their research themes and how they have used the findings, or would use the findings in their practice. The impact, or potential impact on teaching must be discussed.


Mentor FAQs

What is the PebblePad portfolio?

This is the trainee's teaching practice portfolio. It is shared managed by trainees, monitored by tutors and shared with mentors by trainees. Mentors are able to view the contents and edit the Professional Reports and Lesson Observations pages. If you cannot edit PebblePad, Please email Jane or Mike.

What are the stages of the Professional Report 2 and 3 writing?

A tripartite approach to feedback and assessment: the Professional Report (PR) process Note: always meet with your trainee and discuss their review and summary of progress as <u>vour</u> prepare your own PR section
