# UNIVERSITY DIPLOMA IN PRIVATE TUTORING



***Tutoring has become a career – and for people working in the arts and other professions it is increasingly a second career, supplementing their professional endeavours.***

**The University Diploma in Private Tutoring** is a Level 5, 30-credit module for current University of Worcester students, Alumni and the wider community who wish to develop their understanding of pedagogical approaches to tutoring, and enhance the learning and teaching of subject specific content with children, young people and/or adults.

The module is ideal for current students with a particular area of specialism who wish to engage in new, supplementary or additional employment opportunity.

In addition to developing varied tutoring skills, the diploma pays special attention to understanding appropriate safeguarding practices and how safeguarding, tutoring and learning relate to effective tutoring relationships.

**Entry requirements:**

No formal qualifications are required. However it is expected:

- ◆ Solid knowledge of (or professional engagement in) a given subject
- ◆ Successful study at level 3 or 4
- ◆ GCSE grade C (or equivalent) in English and Maths
