Good morning

The existing Library Management System (LMS) is being replaced by a new system. Please read this email to see how you may be affected.

The Go-Live date has been set as Thursday 18th July 2019.

We are aiming to minimise the impact to service delivery as much as possible, but there will be some temporary disruption from Monday 15th July:

- Do not edit or add to <u>resource lists</u> from 15th July until advised.
- There will be no access to online accounts, reservations or renewals w/c 15th July. Loan dates have been extended until 22nd July to prevent fines from accruing during this period.
- Searching for *Books and other media* will be unavailable 15th-18th July.
- Inter-library request applications will be suspended 10th 21st July.
- <u>SCONUL Access applications</u> will be suspended 13th 17th July.
- There will be a limit of 9 renewals per book from 18th July. Renewals on current loans will be reset to zero so you will start with a clean slate.
- Please note that Auto-renewals for University Staff will be temporarily suspended and you will need to renew books at The Hive or online until advised otherwise.

The new system will bring a number of benefits including an improved experience for customers with a modern user interface which is expected to improve search speed, as well as instant item availability (and ability to filter by availability) in the online library catalogue. Further enhancements are expected in the coming months. These include the introduction of online payments for library services and access to the catalogue from mobile devices. The re-procurement of the library management system has reduced licence fees by over 50%.
