Moira's current Action Research PhD explores e-portfolios for student assessment and transformational learning. In 2011 Moira was awarded University of Worcester Teaching Fellow. Moira has worked at a national level as a committee member for her subject association, has been part of the Department for Education National Curriculum Expert Group for Computing and regularly publishes and presents on Computing and Technology Enhanced Learning.
