

University Clinic

Worcester is going to be your home while you are studying at the University, and at some point you may need to see a Doctor. We recommend that you register with a local GP Surgery now, so that if you do need an appointment you can make one as quickly as possible. The University has teamed up with one such local surgery, Farrier House, to open an outreach surgery in Woodbury on St Johns Campus, room WB071. Both students and staff can use the University Clinic to access their GP.

Opening times

Surgery hours are 12 noon - 2pm on a Monday, Wednesday and Friday during semester time.

Outside of campus opening hours, you will be able to access full services at the Farrier House Surgery.
